Abstract

The Common European Framework for Languages. Twenty years later

The essay examines the main features of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages and identifies the main functions performed within the European linguistic policy. The objectives of the first European projects on languages and the roots of the Common European Framework are reconstructed. The strengths and weaknesses of current global linguistic training are highlighted. Attention is also given to the role that the Common European Framework has had on the Italian language for foreigners and the institutional strategies for its diffusion.
